**Ways to Give**



The **MU Student Emergency Fund** allows for flexible responses to emergent needs among our student population. This includes, but is not limited to, emergency housing, food costs and healthcare charges.



**Tiger Pantry** provides food and other resources to our students, as well as staff, faculty and their families. They are offering curbside pickup of staple groceries for those dealing with food insecurity, as well as delivering supplies directly to those at high-risk for severe illness from COVID-19.



The **Diversity Gift Fund** supports programming efforts across campus, including the Gaines/Oldham Black Culture Center, the Multicultural Center, workplace diversity trainings, faculty recruitment and retention plans, and other diversity support services.



**Rally Mizzou** distributes awards to upperclassmen who have fallen behind on tuition, keeping them enrolled and progressing toward graduation. Qualifying students owe \$2000 or less, have completed at least 90 credit hours, and have no disciplinary holds.

Donors enabled the Mizzou Alumni Association to offer digital memberships to every graduating student in the class of 2020 through the \$20 for '20 Campaign.






